On December 13th, VCHS will hold a Distance Learning study day to provide a balance of flexible study time and academic support from teachers. We pray this helps to reduce any stress and anxiety. Students may choose to attend for as little or as much time as they choose, and each subject area is allotted 30 minutes during the day that is dedicated solely to that subject.

Because this date is scheduled as a C-Day Special Schedule on the calendar (rather than an A-Day or B-day), VCHS is not using the Distance Learning schedule located in the [Student Handbook](#). If VCHS needs to move to Distance Learning due to local health regulations, local air quality, etc. on a date listed as an A-Day or B-Day on the school calendar, VCHS will use the Distance Learning schedule that is published.

Attendance Policy

To ensure their technology is working and to be marked present for the day, students should login to their academic teachers' Zoom rooms and comment "Present" in the chat. Students who choose to review at home independently rather than joining their teacher's Zoom for extended review will not be penalized, and any structured review will be recorded and posted by the end of the school day so students who do not join class via Zoom can review on their own schedules. Absences on December 13th will not be tallied in a student's 2021-22 attendance.

FAQs

- **Should students come on campus?** No. Our Distance Learning Study Day on December 13th will be held virtually via Zoom.
- **What if I have more than two courses in the same subject?** VCHS has designed time slots that are 90 minutes long so that students have time to review with more than one teacher during each designated time. Structured review will be recorded and posted by the teacher so that students can watch the review session at the time of their choosing.
- **What about checking Zoom technology for courses without final exams?** Teachers who are not giving a final exam will be present in Zoom for 30 minutes. Teachers will announce these time slots to their students in advance so they know when they can check in. Teachers will work with their students to schedule times that do not conflict with the times their students need to work with other teachers.
