## **General Packing Instructions**

 Make sure all essentials are packed within the carry-on bag: medicine, basic toiletries, money, cell phone with charger and earphones, pillows/blankets, and entertainment for long layovers. Pack your carry-on bag so that you could survive if the checked bag got lost/delayed. Students should be able to manage/carry their own bags. The MAX you can bring (consider less):

- 1 Checked Bags (under 50lbs)
- 1 Carry-on Bag
- 1 Personal backpack

Avoid bringing valuable or sentimental items.

- Most students choose to bring \$100-200 for souvenirs and snacks in the airports.
- We will be visiting during the winter and it will be COLD for us Californians. Pack layers and a warm coat NOT just a hoodie.
- We will be moving rooms EVERY NIGHT please pack light, so it's easy for the whole group to move easily/quickly.
- There will be days of extensive walking on outdoor campus tours. Bring sneakers or boots—not just slippers.
- Have a trusted adult check everything before you pack.
- Make sure your luggage and bags are labeled.

### **General VCHS Dress Code**

 Only bring attire—even for bus or air travel—that is within VCHS dress code (pajama bottoms for travel days are okay, but you should be appropriately dressed for our museum and college visits).
