    - Safety operations




## Project Mangement Career Development

- Mentor programs.






### Project Management Community Awareness

### Project Management Community Giving

The Community Giving Project uses the project management process to raise funds or collect donations to be given to a cause/charity. Examples include...

- Adopt-a-families, etc.




#### Project Management Financial Literacy

- Student loan workshops








The Sales Project uses the project management process to raise funds for the local DECA chapter. Examples include...
