Winnie the Pooh Makeup Instructions

Please Note: Please come to shows on Friday and Saturday (May 16 & 17) <u>with makeup already done</u>. We will have a photographer taking pictures at our Thursday Dress rehearsal. We will add blush and lip color for that day only; you will not need to do their makeup.

For shows, you will need:

Foundation (please match child's skin tone - if in doubt go one shade darker rather than lighter.)

Translucent face powder (make sure this is not tinted) Here is a link for a good inexpensive powder you can find at Ulta: <u>Link</u>

Blush (should be in warm, rosy tones, not cool purple or pink)

Lip color (please match child's lip color as closely as possible. We do not want the lips to look too "made-up" or "grown up". Again, if in doubt, go with a warmer tone rather than a cool tone.)

Girls only: you may use **eyeliner** and/or **mascara** if desired. Black or brown, depending on your haircolor. Please no heavy eyeliner.

Boys do not need eye makeup.

Instructions:

- 1. Start with a clean, dry face. Apply foundation over the whole face in an even layer. Use a brush or sponge to blend in. You do not need to apply to neck, just face and under chin.
- 2. Using a brush, pat a light layer of translucent powder over entire face. Use a patting motion rather than brushing to ensure the powder sticks well.
- 3. Using a brush or sponge, apply blush to the top of the cheek bones, spreading backwards toward the hair. Blend in well. Make sure the blush can be seen - stage lights tend to wash out faces!
- 4. Apply a lipcolor to the lips in an even layer. Make sure to have child blot their lips on a tissue or paper towel.
- 5. If desired, apply eyeliner and/or mascara on girls. This does not need to be heavy, a light coat is fine.
- 6. Put lip color and blush, along with applicator, in a baggie with child's name on it, and send with child on Friday night and Saturday night for the shows.
