Hair Bands

Not every band wore makeup but here's some rocker looks below. We'll be focusing on eyes and big hair for band/rocker characters.



Everyday 80's

Hair is still "big", long on top (and back) and feathered with ears showing.



MAKE UP

Please purchase your base makeup and eye liner at a minimum.

Foundation/Base Makeup

Liquid makeup 1 to 2 shades darker than natural skin tone. If you're wearing facial hair, do not put foundation where glue will be placed. Do not put foundation on your lips.

Eye Liner

Black only. Recommend a cream or creamy application pencil. If it does not have a creamy texture, it will be difficult to apply and smudge. Can be purchased on Amazon or any drug store. Example: <u>NYX Mechanical Eye Pencil, Creamy Retractable</u> (recommended), <u>Black cream eyeshadow</u> from Wet N Wild, <u>Kohl Eyeliner pencil</u> from Wet N Wild.

Powder will be provided to set foundation if needed

Blush/Bronzer/Lipstick will be provided if needed

HAIR

Don't cut your hair. All styles had longer hair.

Many of you will be assigned a wigs and will give you in-person instruction.

Everyone else will style their natural hair. For the Everyday 80's looks refer to the pictures. You'll need to add volume and we'll be using mousse and hairspray to achieve the look.

Gel/Mousse/Hairspray/Brush/Comb - all will be provided unless you prefer to use your own
