HAIR & MAKEUP

Female Basic Stage Makeup

- Step 1: Apply foundation
 - Your foundation should be 1 shade darker than your natural skin tone.
- Step 2: Contour + Highlight
 - Contour is different than blush
- Step 3: Blush
 - NO SHIMMER, GLITTER, OR SPARKLE
 - General rule: the more the better. If you feel like you're wearing too much, you probably aren't wearing enough.
- Step 4: Eyeshadow
 - Keep it basic and neutral
 - Tip: use your contour + highlight shades
- Step 5: Eyeliner
 - Thin line, no wing
 - Use a dark brown or black depending on what compliments your skin tone
- Step 6: Mascara
 - Use black mascara to define your eyelashes
- Optional:
 - Translucent powder - this covers shininess.
 - Natural lip color

Male Basic Stage Makeup

- Step 1: Apply foundation
 - Your foundation should be 1 shade darker than your natural skin tone.
- Step 2: Contour + Highlight
- Step 3: Blush
 - NO SHIMMER, GLITTER, OR SPARKLE

 - Translucent powder - this covers shininess.

Then, put it up.





This headband (knot in front) with some sort of half up, half down look. Natural curls.




HALEY

Bow and one of the following:




